Blessed are the ailing parents of the Founder & President of Atchayam Trust, Mr.P.Naveenkumar M.E., as his actions towards the betterment of a society are always commendable and is focused. He was brought up by his grandmother as his father is physically challenged and couldn't move much while his mother suffers from intense Rheumatoid Arthritis. He worked in fields on morning and cleaned cow dung to manage his school expenses. With this struggling, finally he completed his undergraduate in mechanical engineering in the year 2014 and post graduate in thermal engineering in the year 2016.

The heart wrenching situation of the beggars in the daily life scenario sparked a pinch of thought in Naveen's mind to commit to a vision of creating a beggar free country. Quite normally, he was discouraged for his objective thinking, forcing him to finish his undergraduate studies. Overwhelmingly, he excelled in studies and shined as a topper.

With a fascinating insight into the plights of marginalized people, he created awareness about the plights of beggars among the youths, thereby a dynamic group of student volunteers and other professionals were formed as a team, leading successfully to the establishment of ATCHAYAM TRUST in the year 2014. He was just 20 years young and a final year undergraduate engineering scholar during that course of period. His investments for the welfare of the marginalized people are only his youth and time which will not return in his life span. Despite that, he is attaining a ton of happiness and satisfaction in being a beloved person. Being instrumental in striving for their well-being, he was awarded with National Youth Award by Govt. of India and Chief Minister's State Youth Award by Govt. of Tamilnadu and various 70+ prestigious awards and recognitions.


















A GLIMPSE OF OUR PROJECTS

Atchayam Beggars Rehabilitation Home has been relocated on September 2022 from Soolai locality to NULM-Erode corporation building at Lakkapuram, Solarputhur which was allotted by Erode Municipal corporation. There are 40 beneficiaries in Atchayam Beggars Rehabilitation Home.

Emergency Care and Recovery Centre (ECRC)

Emergency Care and Recovery Centre(ECRC) is located in Perundurai Medical College and Hospital at Perundurai. We have 20 beneficiaries in ECRC. ECRC, mainly works for homeless people with mental illness. Recreational therapies such as yoga & meditation are being provided for their mental well-being.



A domicile of Nepal, Mr.Suman was brought to the concern of our trust from Thanthai Periyar Government Headquarters Hospital, Erode. He was in a mentally impaired condition during the year 2021. After periodical counseling and medical treatments by healthcare professionals, we were delighted to get his personal details. He was a vagabond in search of employment opportunity. By the way, he travelled all over from Nepal to Kerala and to Tamilnadu. He lost his possessions and national identity cards. Due to language problem, he was unable to manage the hard situations and finally he became mentally unstable out of depression. He is a father of two children. With the furnished information, his family was brought to our trust in order to reunite him with his family and it's a grand success. The love of a family is the life's greatest blessing and he was blessed with the same.

Mr.Raghu

On a fine day, 80 year old Mr.Raghu was eagerly waiting outside the premises of JKKN College, Komarapalayam of Namakkal district of Tamilnadu to meet the Founder & President of Atchayam Trust. He hails from Haryana and retired as an English teacher in a private institution. His spouse's death made his life miserable and destitute as he has no children to care for. He lost his identity proofs and was distraught as he could not join any old age home in Delhi. At this time, he was inspired by an article published on 07-Nov-2020 in an English newspaper, 'Times of India' about the works done by our Atchayam trust and that has brought him all over from Haryana. He makes a happy living helping the guard in the safe, friendly environment of the Atchayam Rehabilitation and Skill Development Centre.



Mrs.Ammani Ammal

Being a mother of three children, Mrs.Ammani Ammal, an 87-year old senior citizen was hopelessly living as an alm-seeker in the streets of Erode Sampath Nagar. To realize, she was hurt by no one but her own children. It's truly painful to acknowledge the fact that children have walked out of her life. Our rescue team was put into action in a fast pace in search of her family. Witnessed by the District Superintendent of Police, she was reunited with her third daughter.

Mr.Venkatraman

In addition to the saying, 'Liquor addiction is injurious to health', it also spoils one's family. Mr.Venkatraman, a smoker and a liquor addict's personal and family history is the same. He spent all his earnings for alcohol consumption and due to which a family dispute arose between him and his wife. His addiction increased due to the mental depression and so he could not survive long in workplace. He lost the job and left his home. He engaged himself in begging for his survival. He was rescued by our dynamic team of volunteers and admitted him in Atchayam Rehabilitation Home & Skill Development Centre. He was rehabilitated successfully so that he became a deaddict of alcohol and cigarette consumption. Presently, he is a cook in our Atchayam home and serves the residents of home happily. He was also reunited with his family.



Mrs.Jayalakshmi

with lot of hopes and desire. But the scene was not as expected. She lost her parents at a very young age and was married to Mr.Krishnaraj. The death of a blue baby she gave birth to became the next great loss in her life. This twisting moment turned her into a psychopath and she left home. She became a sexual prey to molesters and was cruelly beaten up. An injur on her leg worsened and developed to skin necrosis that may end up in ECholi infection.

District Mental Health Psychiatrist, Dr. Anantha Kumar counseled her. With the support and guidance of Mr. Srinivasan, an officer of Differently abled Welfare department, she was admitted in Ecomwell Home for Mentally III at Tharamangalam, Salem Dt. She actively involves herself as healthcare taker presently, taking care of the other mentally ill residents of the home.



Mr.Baskar

A resident of Tiruchengode, Mr.Baskar was a vagabond in search of job and so moved to Erode. He was unable to get a job as it was during the covid pandemic period. He was frustrated and depressed and that spoiled his mental health. Due to mental disorder, he wandered on streets and engaged in begging. He survived on food offered by the public and drunk alcohol with the money he begged for, Atchayam team rescued him and admitted in Atchayam Rehabilitation Home & Skill Development Centre. He was later admitted in ECRC, Perundural for his mental well-being. It's delighting that he is recovering gradually.



ESTABLISHMENT OF ATCHAYAM HOME FOR HOMELESS



ATCHAYAM BEGGARS REHABILITATION HOME

- Identifying beggars through survey and rescuing then for counseling and admission in appropriate rehabilitation homes without gender discrimination.
- Solely comforting them with basic needs such as clothes, nutritious meal and a safe environment as a primary activity.
- Analyzing and monitoring for their physical and mental capacity for further relevant rehabilitation strategies and skill development training.
- After diagnosing through a physical exam, lab tests and psychiatric evaluation, rehabilitating them through periodical counseling and various therapies like psychosocial therapy, cognitive behavioral therapy etc,.
- · Assisting them with daily and regular medical care for sound body.
- Facilitating them to obtain social entitlements like disability certificates, electoral card, aadhar card and so on.
- After successful rehabilitation, training them on developing skills according to their ability for leading a decent life and to be self reliant.
- Promoting empowerment by conducting various vocational skill training programmes
- After imparting skills, providing placement assistance in various private firms
 through our immense support and encouraging to be a self-employed one in
 small scale levels through the extension of material support by Atchayam for
 increase in economic benefits of the individual and thereby society.
- · Involving them in activities for social integration.
- · Possibly, reintegrating the beneficiary with his/her family for one's happy living.

ATCHAYAM DESTITUTE HOME (HOSPICE CARE)

- · Atchayam Hospice Care functions for the concern of dying destitute.
- Dying destitute are helpless, hopeless and homeless people seen on the pavements in public places.
- These people are abandoned by their own families mainly due to their serious medical condition.
- · They are deprived of medical attention and care.
- They need utmost medical care 24x7 to alleviate their sufferings and unbearable pain.
- These people are to be rescued from an identified location and provide care with medical and moral support.
- This specialized Atchayam Hospice Care addresses physical comfort, emotional and spiritual support for the people in their twilight years

"WE RISE BY LIFTING OTHERS,,

ATCHAYAM OLD AGE HOME

- Atchayam Geriatric Care refers to a specialized care for senior citizens to meet their requirements.
- To emphasize, they are economically unproductive due to aging effects and are thus abandoned by their own families.
- These abandoned elders belonging to the age group of 60 years and above are proportionately mixed with rescued beggars.
- These old people indulge themselves in begging for food and are found on the streets as they are deprived of shelter.
- · They are liable to health issues often and are left uncared mostly.
- · Showering them with tender love, care and affection by health care takers.
- Deeply counseling them by expert counselors with a great concern on their mental well being.
- Assisting them with 24x7clinical care by the physicians, physiotherapy treatments, nursing facility and supplementary medicines free of cost.
- · Supplying a balanced diet, dressing materials, toiletries etc. for the residents.

ATCHAYAM HOME FOR MENTALLY ILL

- · Atchayam Home for Psychotic is for patients with psychiatric disorders.
- The deep frustration and depression due to the death of loved ones and family breakdown are the predominant factors that make a person psychotic.
- It is an urgency need to rescue the mentally ill person and admit in rehabilitation home for their mental recovery as they threaten the public usually.
- Optimal mental health care ensuring people with mental illness are practiced with the same medical and social care as like normal people.
- Involving the patients in recreational activities like meditation, playing games, dancing etc., and practicing yoga for emotional, psychological and social well being.
- Engaging them in activities that promote mental health is an essential determining factor in living a healthy and happy lifestyle.
- · An environmental set up that supports mental health and serenity.
- Mental health services including medications for anxiety or depression, health visits by psychologists and therapist and consulting with the social worker

ATCHAYAM SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

- Cultivating and developing the artistic knowledge through skill development programmes.
- Imparting skills to the beneficiaries for empowering them through Vocational and Skill Development Training.
- · Unleashing the potential capabilities of each beneficiary.
- · Enhancing confidence and hope of independent living.
- · Enhancing employability options for self sustained livelihood.
- · Improved standard of living.
- Improving the lives of marginalized individual improves the nation's development thereby functioning as a catalyst for social transformation.

HELP US BUILD A NEW ATCHAYAM HOME FOR HOMELESS

ECCENTRIC FEATURES

- The beneficiaries are encouraged to occupy themselves in common daily work activities through incentives provided according to the work done on a given day.
- Disbursement of the loan to the beneficiary who is willing to set up an enterprise of his own.
- Financial assistance as seed money is provided in the range of INR 3000 to 6000 INR.
- The successful rehabilitants can independently run the shops and stalls for their income.
- Enjoying ownership by marketing the self made products through the inculcated skills attained by vocational and skill training programme.
- Remedial measures for the mental health of the beneficiaries include
 - Various psychotherapies like CBT etc.
- Animal assisted therapy that reduces emotional and psychiatric symptoms such as anxiety and depression.
- Relaxation techniques like yoga, breathing, meditation that helps in reducing the anxiety and stress that affects social, work or personal lives.
- Health services such as Counseling Psychology to improve the mental ability of a person to function better in their lives.
- Ensuring a wide range of quality medical and nursing care by setting up a Medical Unit.

NOTE

All the savings in running an eco friendly home can be put towards other reasonable benefits for the residents

REMARKABLE INFRASTRUCTURE

- A temple, a representation of religion and art and a place of peace and happiness for the supreme mental well being of the beneficiaries.
- A common prayer hall irrespective of religion to gain spiritual intelligence which is the ability
 to apply and embody spiritual resources and qualities to enhance daily functioning and
 wellbeing.
- A central dining room for the people from different walks of life to gather and realize the feeling of oneness.
- A central library with a serene and disciplined atmosphere to provide an ease of access to information and resources.
- Research block to focus on various measures to improve the welfare of the beneficiaries and emphasize awareness to create a beggar free country in the minds of the youth for better posterity.
- Sports Club with a concern for sound body of the beneficiaries that also fosters intimate friendship and supports in developing positive attitude, self-confidence, courage and patience.
- The pleasant greenery view and the fresh air in open spaces enhance the health benefits as it has a positive psychological impact by lowering stress, depression and anxiety.
- Farming of crops, a part of agriculture is essentially to be done by the beneficiaries, for the beneficiaries that aids in mental relaxation apart from engaging them in physical activity. Also, it adds to their income.
- Better organic yields obtained through farming serves as a healthy meal for the residents
 too.
- More sustainable and eco friendly environment: Installing rain water harvesting system to conserve water, eco friendly lighting to save energy and usage of eco friendly products.
- Farming also supports an eco friendly environment A shady landscape around the home reduces the energy consumption and keeps the home cool even during summers.
- Realizing that every creature is a valuable on earth, letting our yard to grow a little animal species like pet animals, birds and fishes that also boosts up mental health of the residents.
